



Kodanda Rama, copper, South India, 19th century A.D.

Stylized after the earlier classical bronzes, this image depicts 'Kodanda' Rama—arrayed in battle dress, a quiver of arrows on his back, his hands poised to draw the bow.

On the right:

Part of a 'jhoola' decoration, lacquered and painted wood, probably Jaipur, 19th century A.D.

During the 'Janmashtami' festival, such decorative 'jhoolas', the supporting frames intricately carved with incidents from the life of Krishna, and other motifs, are used for the worship of Krishna.
