IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PASSENGERS.

CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE: An extract from the General Conditions under which passengers and baggage are carried by the Company will be found in every air ticket. A complete copy of the General Conditions of carriage may be inspected at any of the Company's Offices or airports.

RESERVATIONS: A reservation cannot be regarded as definite until the full fare has been paid.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations that are notified to the Company less than 24 hours prior to departure are subject to forfeiture of the full fare. In the case of cancellations that are notified to the Company more than 24 hours prior to departure, telegraphic and all other out-of-pocket expenses will be recoverable.

CHILDREN'S FARES: Children under 2 years of age and not occupying a separate seat will be charged 10 % of the published fare, and such passengers will not be entitled to any free baggage allowance. Children over 2 years and under 12 years of age will be charged 50 % of the published fare and will be entitled to a free baggage allowance of 22 lbs together with full unregistered baggage allowance. Not more than one infant at 10 % of the fare may accompany one adult full fare paying passenger. Not more than three children may accompany one adult passenger and not more than one of these may be under 2 years. All children accompanying an adult must be booked at the same time.

BAGGAGE—FREE ALLOWANCE: The free baggage allowance is 44 lbs. per adult passenger. Children under 12 years and over 2 years, paying half fare, are only entitled to 22 lbs of free baggage. Children under 2 years paying 10 % of the published fare are not entitled to any free baggage allowance.

BAGGAGE—UNREGISTERED: A passenger may carry free of charge not more than 5 lbs. of unregistered hand baggage. The only items permissible under this heading are brief cases, overcoats, mackintoshes, lady's hand bags, walking sticks and umbrellas. Portable typewriters may not be included.

VALIDITY OF RETURN TICKETS: One year,

BROKEN JOURNEYS: Breaks of journey over any one route will be permitted at the through fare subject to the provision that breaks of journey must be pre-booked and that the entire journey between the two termini in relation to the particular journey shall be completed within 30 days from the date of the first journey.

CAMERAS: May be carried provided they are packed in baggage to which the passenger has no access during flight. Passengers must not carry cameras in their unregistered hand luggage.

SMOKING: Is not permitted in aircraft.

LIVESTOCK: Cannot be accepted for carriage.

FIREARMS AND AMMUNITION; Suitably packed Firearms and Ammunition will be accepted for carriage on condition that they are declared and surrendered to the custody of the Commander of the aircraft before embarkation. Service personnel are permitted to retain their Firearms and Ammunition provided they are declared to the Commander of the aircraft before embarkation and that the Firearms remain unloaded
