

unscheduled nightstop. The Company accepts no liability for the cost of meals, and hotel accommodation in the case of passengers booked to embark at a station where an interruption of the flight takes place or in a case where passengers have not actually commenced the air journey.

#### 20. Light Refreshments and Meals.

In all cases of delay, refreshments and meals served to passengers will be at the Company's expense.

#### 21. Loss of Ticket.

No passenger will be allowed to embark or continue his journey when it is known that he is not in possession of a ticket. In the case of a lost ticket, the passenger will be required to sign the Company's Indemnity Form before a fresh ticket is issued for the journey in question.

#### 22. Precious Cargo.

Precious cargo will not be accepted for the present. For the information of the public, precious cargo consists of bullion, jewellery, bank notes, specie, valuable oil paintings, objects of art and other commodities of a similar nature.

#### 23. Punctuality.

Every effort is made to ensure the punctuality of all services, but the carrier cannot accept responsibility for any delay to or suspension of a service.

Embarking passengers should present themselves at the Company's office at the airport of embarkation (or elsewhere if so required by the carrier) at the time indicated when booking.

#### 24. Connections with other Services.

The obligation of the carrier is expressly limited to the journey between the places of departure and destination and shall not in any event subsist previous or subsequent thereto, in particular no part of any journey undertaken by air previous or subsequent to the carriage specified on the ticket, shall be deemed to form part of such carriage. The carrier accordingly does not undertake to establish connection with any air service at the places of departure or destination specified on the ticket.

The Company will not accept liability for hotel accommodation and meals at the station of transfer to a foreign service or to another of the Company's services.

#### 25. Smoking.

Smoking will not be permitted in or in the vicinity of aircraft.

#### 26. Gratuities.

Staff are not permitted to accept gratuities.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CARRIAGE.

1. Before undertaking a journey passengers must be in possession of a ticket, which will be issued subject to the General Conditions of Carriage exhibited at all offices of the Company and reproduced on the ticket, and to the Company's general regulations contained herein.

2. Rebates.

Servants of the Government of India, Provincial Governments and Governments of Indian States through whose territory the Company operates, will be entitled to a rebate of 5% of the published fare when travelling on duty. This rebate is applicable only when the passenger is travelling on duty.

For return passages booked in advance, a rebate of 10% on the single fare will be allowed in respect of the return journey.

In the case of "through bookings" with B.O.A.C., the Company will honour B.O.A.C. "Government Servants" rebates up to 5% of the published fare.

Claims for rebates must be received by the Company prior to embarkation. All applications for rebates must be supported by Certificate of Status or other documentary evidence.

Except the Government Servants' rebate of 5%, no other rebate shall be cumulative.

3. Free Baggage Allowance.

The free baggage allowance is 44 lbs. per adult passenger. Children over 2 years and under 12 years, paying half fare, are only entitled to 22 lbs. of free baggage. Children under 2 years, paying 10% of the published fare are not entitled to any free baggage allowance.

4. Unregistered Baggage.

A passenger may carry free of charge not more than 5 lbs. of unregistered hand-baggage. The only items permissible under this heading are brief cases, overcoats, mackintoshes, ladies' hand-bags, walking sticks and umbrellas. Portable typewriters are not to be included.

5. Children's Fares.

Children under 2 years of age and not occupying a separate seat will be charged 10% of the published fare, and such passengers will only be entitled to 5 lbs. of unregistered free baggage. Children over 2 years and under 12 years of age will be charged 50% of the published fare and will be entitled to a free baggage allowance of 22 lbs. together with the full unregistered baggage allowance.

Not more than one infant at 10% of the fare may accompany one adult full fare-paying passenger.

Not more than three children may accompany one adult passenger and not more than one of these may be under 2 years. All children accompanying an adult must be booked at the same time.

6. Reservations.

A reservation cannot be regarded as definite until the full fare has been paid.

7. Telegrams and Telephone Calls.

Passengers will be required to meet the cost of all trunk calls in connection with their bookings. Certain telegraphic expenses incurred in connection with reservations are also payable by the passenger. All telegraphic expenses in connection with cancelled reservations will have to be borne by the passenger.

8. Cancellations.

Cancellations that are notified to the Company less than 24 hours prior to departure are subject to forfeiture of the full fare.

In the case of cancellations that are notified to the Company more than 24 hours prior to departure, telegraphic and all other out-of-pocket expenses will be recoverable.

9. Broken Journeys.

Breaks of journey over any one route will be permitted at the through fare subject to the provision that breaks of journey must be pre-booked and that the entire journey between the two termini in relation to the particular journey shall be completed within 30 days from the date of the first journey.

10. Carriage of Children.

Children between the ages of 10 and 16 may travel unaccompanied provided the Company receives the written consent of the parents or the legal guardian. Children under the age of 10 will not be carried unaccompanied under any circumstances.

11. Contents of Passengers' Baggage.

Passengers' Baggage must contain bona fide personal effects only.

12. Refusal of Passengers.

The Company reserves the right to refuse travel facilities to any passenger who by his general behaviour and/or physical condition may be a source of discomfort or danger to the other passengers and crew. The decision in such cases shall remain at the sole discretion of the Commander of the Service concerned and the Senior Traffic Representative of the Company at the station.

Such refusal may take place either at the time of embarkation or at a subsequent station. Any question of refund in such cases will be referred to Head Office.

13. Carriage of Invalids.

Invalids will be carried at the Company's discretion and subject to the following restrictions:—

- (a) Invalids without an attendant will not be carried unless they are sitting cases and do not require the assistance of other passengers or members of the crew during the journey.
- (b) Stretcher cases must be accompanied by an attendant.
- (c) In the case of the Company accepting an invalid passenger, a certificate acceptable to the Company from a competent medical officer confirming that the passenger is fit to travel by air and will not inconvenience, or endanger the health of other passengers must be provided.

14. Surface Transport.

The Company is not committed to provide surface transport between airports and cities, but wherever the Company has a sufficient number of vehicles to permit of it, free surface transport will be provided between the airports and the Company's City Office. Passengers are advised to verify arrangements at the time of booking.

15. Livestock.

Livestock cannot be accepted for carriage.

16. Cheques.

Passengers should kindly note that the Company's staff are not empowered to accept cheques.

17. Fire Arms and Ammunition.

Suitably packed fire arms and ammunition will be accepted for carriage on condition that they are declared and surrendered to the custody of the Commander of the aircraft before embarkation.

Service personnel are permitted to retain their fire arms and ammunition provided they are declared to the Commander of the aircraft before embarkation and that the fire arms remain unloaded.

18. Cameras.

Cameras may be carried provided they are packed in baggage to which the passenger has no access during the flight. Passengers must not carry cameras in their unregistered hand-baggage.

19. Cost of Hotel Accommodation in Cases of Unscheduled Nightstops.

The Company will bear the cost of hotel accommodation and surface transport for all transit passengers in the case of a service making an
