The Air-India Art Collection

Through the ages, artists and artisans have been sponsored and fostered by Royalty, Aristocracy and the Church. In India too, many a craft and school of art developed and blossomed due to religious and royal patronage.

The empires of old are no more and the princes of yesteryear have faded away as patrons of the Arts. But Art is still a living vital force and this has created a new class of art collectors.

Museums, industrial corporations, banks, insurance companies, and millionaire collectors are increasingly becoming art patrons, with determined acumen and magnificently rewarding returns, both aesthetic and financial.

Air-India is justifiably proud to be a prominent art patron in India.

The Air-India Collection had its beginning about twenty-five years ago, with the acquisition of a set of six water-colours by a young contemporary painter. These were reproduced on a series of menu cards and used on our international flights.

The success of this experiment led to further and continuous purchases of both contemporary and traditional Indian art — a sustained and discriminating acquisition of items from various sources.

Today, the Collection comprises nearly 3000 art objects ranging from contemporary masterpieces of painting, sculpture and ceramics by acclaimed veterans as well as promising newcomers, to curios, antiques and traditional objets d'art in stone and wood, textile, metal and ivory — miniature paintings and glass paintings, playing cards, nut-cutters, oil lamps et al ...

The Corporation's Collection is not housed in a museum amenable only to a fortunate few. Items from the Collection embellish the decor of Air-India's worldwide offices and are reproduced on publicity material like calendars, diaries, menu cards, postcards and brochures; they are the inspiration for the elegant Indian motifs reproduced in the interiors of Air-India's jet aircraft — all contributing to create the Indian identity which is part of the airline's distinctive personality, established over the years on five continents.

Air-India's 1981 desk diary combines the practical requirements of everyday life with the timelessness of great art. Inspired by the gracefully arched windows of Air-India's aircraft, each page recreates the motifs from the exotic interiors of the aircraft — the immortal legends of Lord Krishna; the refined beauty of the Ajanta frescoes; the Indian villager at work and at leisure

The coloured plates provide a glimpse of the Air-India Collection of traditional art — a 10th century sandstone figure of Vishnu, awesome in its spiritual dignity of form and expression; a bejewelled Nawab, huqqa in hand, painted on glass; a casket engraved with lacelike tracery; unusual nut-cutters. Also included are a few items of non-Indian origin which are a valuable part of the Collection — the fanciful French Breguet clock, complete with a demure maiden reclining on an elephant, and the exquisite decorative pottery from Japan.

Air-India's patronage of art is not only of immense value in preserving the great artistic heritage of India's past and of encouraging that of the present. It is also a very special and effective means of projecting India to the rest of the world, and of creating an airline that is both distinctively and beautifully Indian.





The 'dial-in' code generally remains the same, internationally, whilst the access code or 'dial-out' code varies from country to country. It is necessary to dial this code first, as it provides connection to the international exchange and is generally followed by a changed dial tone. One must then dial the country code followed by the city/area code, and the required subscriber's telephone number.




