SRINGAR

Since time immemorial, man has used his ingenuity and skill to beautify and decorate himself in countless diverse ways. Primitive man painted brilliant colours over his body and wore the briefest covering made of bark, leaves or grass. Gradually, natural materials gave way to woven fabric, and painted design to ornaments of bone, teeth, and later even wood and metal.

SRINGAR is a Sanskrit word meaning "adornment" or the art of decoration.

Stringar is also befittingly, the name of the Air-India exhibition of fifty four dazzling and colourful costumes of India.

In keeping with its policy of propagating Indian art, craft and culture to other parts of the world, Air-India acquired this unique collection of costumes. The collection was researched, compiled and collected for Air-India by Indian designer Roshan Kalapesi after nearly a year of country-wide travel, and devised into a travelling exhibit by the National Institute of Design, Ahmedabad, India. Several State Governments and leading personalities and dancers contributed costumes to the collection.

The vast sub-continent of India is a land of contrasts. It embraces a wide variety of people and landscapes, cultures and life-styles. Steeped in their own traditions, the people of India express their regional heritage in the language they speak, the way they live, the food they eat, and the clothes they wear.

Stringar reflects one significant facet of this rich cultural complexity — the art of the craftsmen as manifest in the amazing diversity of Indian costumes from different regions — the varying weaves and drapes, designs and styles, ornaments, footwear and headgear. Evident in this collection is the art of the weaver, embroiderer, goldsmith, cobbler and jeweller — crafts still alive and flourishing on this sub-continent.

Selected for the distinct style, cut, or drape, the costumes range from the 25 cm. strip cloth loin covering and chunky colourful beads of the Bondo tribal, to the

elaborately gold embroidered ensemble of the Maharani of Jaipur, whose skirt billows into metres of brilliant silk and odhni (scarf) bears a heavy fringe of pure gold.


The colourful and embroidered peasant costumes with their heavy silver and bead ornaments reveal the impulse of beautification even amongst the simplest folk, while the royal costumes are remnants of the opulence of a recently bygone regal era. The dance costumes ranging from the folk to the classical — carry a glamour, boldness and tradition of their own.

Each exhibit in the collection is authentic and original and has been collected from its place of origin. The unique feature of this pageant is that it represents costumes still visible in India, which is one of the few countries where people continue to maintain traditional styles of dress.

After its debut in Bombay in 1976, Sringer was exhibited at the Australian Museum, Sydney, and then at the Natural History Museum of the Smithsonian Institution, Washington D.C. Over the last five years it has been exhibited at leading museums at Edmonton, Calgary and Montreal in Canada, and in the USA at St.Petersburg-Florida, Charleston-South Carolina, and St.Paul-Minnesota. It has drawn large audiences and won wide acclaim and publicity for India.

In this diary, we present special aspects of the costumes in the collection. Due to limitations of space, only a few costumes could be represented. However, the colour plates of the close-up views of different items of dress and jewellery afford a rare opportunity to the viewer to appreciate in fine detail the magnificence and excellence of Indian craftsmanship. The illustrations featured on each diary page provide a glimpse of the intriguing variety of Indian costumes, as worn by people from different regions.

The last page of the diary reproduces the entire list of costumes in the collection, and the categories into which they have been devised for the exhibition.

The 'dial-in' code generally remains the same, internationally, whilst the access code or 'dial-out' code varies from country to country. It is necessary to dial this code first, as it provides connection to the international exchange and is generally followed by a changed dial tone. One must then dial the country code followed by the city/area code, and the required subscriber's telephone number.



This World Holiday chart has been prepared for your convenience in planning your business or holiday programme for 1982. and the dates specified should be considered as an approximate guide. In most countries, public holidays fall into three categories; bank holidays, local holidays, (which may sometimes apply only to a particular city or state), and religious holidays, (which are sometimes only for a particular community). In fact, sometimes, dates need not necessarily be uniform throughout a country. The dates marked with an * are subject to change, as they mostly represent religious holidays, which cannot be accurately forecast in advance, the dates being subject to the sighting of the new moon and the lunar calendar. The actual dates are usually announced by the concerned authorities nearer the time of the religious occasion. Also, dates for public holidays may be sometimes changed, or announced at a variance, to suit current local conditions. Sometimes if a public holiday falls on a weekend holiday, either the preceding or the following day is observed as a public holiday.

INDIAN HOLIDAYS

This is a comprehensive list of national, regional and religious holidays. All these are not observed at an all-India level, but a certain number are declared Central Government holidays at the beginning of the year. A selection of the remaining holidays are declared restricted holidays i.e., to be observed by a particular religious community only. State Governments announce their own individual holiday lists, as applicable to their regions. As these dates may be subject to change, it is advisable to check in advance.




