3. At ROME

Depart 0900 hrs. for a comprehensive full day guided sightseeing tour of Rome. The tour will cover most points of touristic interests such as Colloseum, Roman Forum, Arch de Constantine, Vittorio Emanuel Sq. with its imposing victory memorial, Fontana de Trevi, Spanish Steps etc. and the Villa Borghese. You will be taken inside to see the gallery

Borghese — former residence of the Borghese noble family and which now houses

some of the finest collection of sculpture, paintings and frescos in Italy.

In the afternoon visit the holy city of Vatican with its beautiful columnaded St. Peter's Sq., the St. Peter's Church and then on to the Vatican Museum including the famed Sistine Chapel, (paintings by Michael Angelo), Rapheal's room, etc. Return to hotel in the evening.

Depart 0830 hrs. for a picturesque journey through the captivating Dolomites. For Innsbruck — Capital of the Tyrol district of Austria. We will visit the St. Jacob's Cathedral which contains a grand organ dating back to 1600 AD and is one of the finest Churches in Europe. We also see briefly the old town with the golden roof. Transfer to hotel Union on arrival.

The Tyrol district is famous for its colourful Folklore shows and we will depart at 1800 hrs. to witness one such spectacular show. On completion of the show, you

will be taken for an Indian dinner at Sher-e-Punjab

7. INNSBRUCK — ZURICH 300 kms. — 5½ hrs.

Depart 0830 hrs. for another days picturesque journey en-route to Zurich. On arrival the group will be taken for a brief panoramic sightseeing tour — see the Fraununster Church (Windows by Marc Chagall), Gross Minister Church (the largest Romanesque Church in Switzerland), the Tower Clock (diameter 28') — the largets Tower Clock in Europe etc. Then proceed to Holiday Inn, Regensdorf near the airport. Indian style dinner at hotel.

ZURICH

8. Depart 0900 hrs. to Lovely Engelberg, then take a thrilling cable car ride to the summit of Mt. Titlis — 10,000 ft. height — the highest point of Central Switzerland. Then proceed by Coach to the picturesque old town of Lucerne with its old wooden bridges, the Town Hall and the Lake Lucerne. You will be given 2 hrs. time for shopping and other leisure activities

like boating in Lake Lucerne. (You could pick-up good watches, clocks at reasonable prices).

Return to hotel.

9. ZURICH — FARNKFURT-425 kms. — 7 hrs. VIA RHINE FALLS & STTUTGART

Depart 0730 hrs. for Frankfurt via Rhine Falls.

We then continue to Sttutgart and stop at the DIAMLER-BENZ factory. We visit the BENZ Museum — a treat for anyone interested in automobiles. Then continue to Frankfurt and check in at Holiday Inn — city tower or similiar.

Depart 1830 hrs. for a brief panoramic guided sightseeing tour of Frankfurt and then on to an Indian Restaurant for a Hearty meal.

Evening free to explore the night life in/around Sachsenhausen.





10. FRANKFURT — COLOGNE — 190 kms. — 4½ hrs. RHINE CRUISE En-route.

Depart 0900 hrs. for RUDESHEIM from where we get aboard a luxury steamer for an enchanting cruise down the River Rhine gliding through scenic country-side vineyards and past majestic castles upto St. Goar. The Cruise will be for about two hours duration. Then continue by coach Via Bonn for Cologne. On arrival transfer to hotel PLM or similar.

Cologne is a good place for bargain shopping. So at 1600 hrs. the coach will drop you at the shopping centre. Pick-up time for return to the hotel will

be advised.

11. COLOGNE — AMSTERDAM — 270 kms. 4½ hrs.

Depart hotel at 0830 hrs. — first we do our sightseeing tour of Cologne famous for its Cathedral built in Gothic style which we shall visit and then the historical Roman Cologne, the Town

Hall, the City Wall etc. We leave the city at noon on our way to Amsterdam via Dusseldorf where we shall stop briefly.

On arrival transfer to hotel Alpha Novotel.

In the evening at 1930 hrs. you will be taken to an Indian Restaurant for dinner. Return transfer to hotel. You may like to visit some of the famous night life areas like Leidsepliein, Rembrandtsplein.

12. At Amsterdam depart 0900 hrs. on a guided sightseeing tour. You shall be taken on a visit to the renowned Diamond factory where craftsmen display their expertise in the art of diamond cutting. Then you continue on a panoramic sight-seeing tour of the city and proceed to the suburbs towards Volendam. Enroute you stop for a visit to the cheese factory and Sabot factory (wooden shoes) - so typically Dutch. You than continue to Volendam and old Dutch village where men, women and children still go about their daily chores in traditional Dutch costumes. On completion of this tour, you will be taken to the Central Railway Station from where you will be taken on a Motor Boat ride through the fabled net-work of Canals of Amsterdam. Return to hotel. Evening at leisure.

13. AMSTERDAM — BRUSSELS — 225 kms. 4½ hrs. VIA HAGUE

Depart 0830 hrs. — we first visit Hague — Centre of World Court — en-route pass through the beautiful country side with flower decked beds and the legendary wind mills of Holland. The highlight of the visit to the Hague is Madurodam — a miniature exhibition of Holland with moving objects and models creating a real life atmosphere. Then continue to Brussels.

On arrival Brussels, we will take a guided sightseeing tour of the City covering Manneken Pis, St. Michael's Cathedral, Grand Place, Law Courts etc. Transfer to

hotel Hyatt Regency.

Indian dinner in the evening.

14. BRUSSELS - PARIS - 280 kms. - 41/2 hrs.

Depart 0830 hrs. for Gay Pari. To arrive by 1300 hrs. Check-in to hotel Penta or similar and after a brief rest leave the hotel at 1430 hrs. for Versailles — a short distance away, formerly the capital of the French Empire till the revolution. The Versailles Palace built in the early 17th century by Louis XIV is majestic and situated amidst beautifully land scaped and expansive gardens. You will visit the Inner Chambers of the Palace — the Grand Appartments, the Chapel, the Hall of Mirrors etc. with gold, marble, Exquisite Tapestry and art objects to reflect the richness of one of the most opulent periods of French history. Then take a walk through the gardens around the palace adorned by statues and fountains. Return to hotel around 1800 hrs.

Depart 2030 hrs. to 'Dekho Dekho' what made Shammi Kapoor go Ga Ga singing 'AN EVENING IN PARIS'. Yes, the city throbs at night — brightly lit around the Monuments, glittering avenues and exciting night clubs. Our tour will be panoramic in nature. We can arrange an optional tour to the Lido or Moulin Rouge at extra cost.

15. At Paris — Depart 1000 hrs. for a comprehensive half-day sightseeing tour of the city — covering Arc de Triumphe, Champs Ellysees, Notterdam Cathedral, place de la Concorde, Cleo Patra's Needle etc. and then visit the great Louvre Museum which among many other things, houses the world famous portrait of Monalisa by the versatile Leonardo da Vinci. The tour will end at Eiffel Tower. You could go up the Eiffel Tower on your own. Balance day/evening at leisure.

16. PARIS - LONDON - 6 hrs.

Depart 0800 hrs. for Calais to board Ferry to Dover and then by coach to London. Tour ends on arrival London.

You may stay back in London on your own and return to India within the validity of your Air Ticket or continue your journey to New York at extra cost. Hotel accommodation at London can be arranged at special rates at extra cost.

9. ZURICH - PARIS: 490 kms. 9 hrs.

Depart 0800 hrs. for Paris. Check into hotel Penta or similar. Depart 2030 hrs. to see what made Shammi Kapoor go Ga Ga singing 'AN EVENING IN PARIS'. Yes, the city throbs at night — brightly lit around the monuments, glittering avenues and exciting night clubs. Our tour will be panoramic in nature. We can arrange an optional tour to the Lido or Moulin Rouge at extra cost.

10. 12. At NEW YORK — Depart 0930 hrs. for a comprehensive sightseeing tour of this great city's Manhattan area, and Harlem, upto 145th Street. The tour route passes by Lincoln Centre, Central Park, Time Square, the glamorous Fifth Avenue, Rockfeller Centre, World Trade Centre, UN Headquarters and the other great skyscrapers of New York to Star Ferry where you board the Statue of Liberty Ferry for an invigorating ride across the bay to Liberty Island and a one-hour visit to the Statue of Liberty. Afternoon — free for shopping/visiting on your own the Observation Desk of the two tallest buildings in New York — the Empire State Building and the World Trade Centre.

Departure - JFK 1145 hrs. UR 39

Arrival - BUF 1255 hrs.

On arrival, transfer to hotel John's Niagra or similar. Depart 1500 hrs. for a comprehensive guided sightseeing tour. First, there will be a thrilling ride aboard the Maid of the Mist to the foot of the Niagra Falls, then followed by a coach tour for a panoramic viewing of the Falls and many other attraction spots. In the evening, you can on your own view the grand illuminations of the Falls with constantly changing colour-shades and powered by 4.2 billion candle power

14. NIAGRA — ORLANDO (via Cleveland)

Depart for Airport at 0530 hrs. to board United Airlines flight for Orlando.

Departure — Buffalo 0700 hrs. UA 339/733

Arrival - Orlando 1054 hrs.

On arrival, transfer to hotel Quality Inn or similar. Depart 1330 hrs. for a tour to Sea World. It is America's biggest and most ellaborate marine life park spread over 125 acres — see Shamu, the country's most popular killer whale, trained Dolphins that come up to be kissed, Seals, Sea Lions and Penguins performing for your pleasure. You also come face to face with SHARK ENCOUNTER, and experience the excitement of meeting these awesome creatures of the deep. Return to hotel.

- 15. Day at WALT DISNEY WORLD We will provide you with transfers from hotel to Walt Disney World and back and an admission booklet to 8 attractions in this magic kingdom. It will surely be a day of delight and sheer fun.
- 16. At EPCOT CENTER America's newest attraction it is a journey through two incredible dimensions future world that will combine Disney



story-telling with state of the earth technical marvels resulting in some of the most dazzling special effects ever seen. Then there is the world show-case where nine nations will stand side by side in friendship — imagine dining at Alfredo's in Rome, celebrating Oktoberfest in a German Beer Garden or trekking through a Canadian wilderness. We shall provide transfers and admission tickets to a few attractions.

17 ORLANDO — WASHINGTON (via Cleveland)

Depart 1030 hrs. for Orlando Airport Departure — Orlando 1215 hrs. UA 734/1036

Arrival — Washington 1655 hrs. On arrival, transfer to hotel Park Central or similar. Evening at leisure.



18. At WASHINGTON — Depart 0900 hrs.

for a half day sightseeing tour of the capital of USA. The tour views such highlights as the Capitol Hill area, the Supreme Court, the Library of Congress and Pentagon, the Federal Triangle, many monuments, the White House and the Lincoln and Jefferson Memorials.

In the afternoon, it is recommended that you visit on your own the Smithsonian Institution, the National Gallery of Art as it is best done individually — the displays are all explained and documented.

19. WASHINGTON - SAN FRANCISCO

Morning at leisure. It is recommended that you go on your own early morning to the White House where there is a queue to get in and view some of the rooms of this most famous house in the world — the seat/residence of the President of the United States.

Depart for airport at 1430 hrs.

Departure — Washington 1730 hrs. UA 57

Arrival — San Francisco 2020 hrs.

On arrival, transfer to hotel Oxford or similar.

20. SAN FRANCISCO — LOS ANGELES

Depart 1030 hrs. from the hotel with baggage. First we take a sightseeing tour of one of the poshest cities of America — see the Civic Center, the Opera House, Old Mission Dolores (where San Francisco was founded), take a seaside view of the Pacific Ocean at the Cliff House and then cross the spectacular 'golden gate bridge', view the Fisherman's Wharf and Pier 39. Then continue on an unforgettable one and quarter hour narrated-steamer cruise on the San Francisco Bay.

Then proceed to San Francisco Airport.

Departure San Francisco — 1830 hrs. UA 1135 Arrival — Los Angeles 1938 hrs.

On arrival transfer to hotel Ambassador or similar.

21. LOS ANGELES -

Depart 0900 hrs. for a combined tour of the famous Universal Studios and the Hollywood Movie Stars' Homes and Beverly Hills. At the world's largest motion picture studio, you will travel aboard a glamour tram to see where your favourite movies and TV shows are made. A studio guide takes you for a behind the scene look at 'special effects' such as the deadly shark attack from Jaws, a chilling alpine avalanche, etc. plus sets, props, costumes and live shows. In the second leg of our tour, you will pass by the fabulous mansions of Hollywood's Movie Stars, the famed Mann's Chinese Theatre, the Hollywood Bowl and the world renowned Sunset Strip, as also a brief visit to the Farmer's market. Return to hotel.

You can return to India any time within 120 days of your date of commencement of travel.

LONDON is one city we have not included in this itinerary since most of you have friends or relations to stay with. On your return travel to India, you can stop at London enroute as all Air-India flights from New York touch down at London enroute to India. PAYMENT

The balance amount is to be paid three weeks prior to departure date. CANCELLATION AND REFUND
