## HOW TO BECOME A REGISTERED MEMBER

All you have to do is complete the Enrolment Card and hand it to the Steward or Stewardess and you will be registered at the Junior Jet Club Headquarters in London. Please complete the Enrolment Card carefully, giving your full name and address so that we can send you the Junior Jet Club Newsletter "Fleetwings". As a registered member, you will receive "Fleetwings" twice a year.

You will also be entitled to a *special mileage certificate* for every 25,000 miles you travel on B.O.A.C. aircraft. As soon as you have flown your first 25,000 miles, please send your log book to

Don't forget to carry your log book whenever you fly by B.O.A.C., and ask the Steward or Stewardess to arrange for the Captain to sign it for you.
