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A Kashmiri Woman

The dress of this light-eyed, clear-skinned Kashmiri reflects the verdant vale of Kashmir. Across the forehead, she wears the tikka jhumka daar, in kandarkani (chasing) with inlay, and hanging from her hair, pousseena raz, (flower chains) which end in kaarvaj. The earrings are kaandaar (bell shaped) and the necklace, battiphul (star and leaf shaped plaques linked by delicate chains). She wears a pheran (loose knee-length garment), esar (trousers), and a pooch (scarf). The hand-embroidered pheran depicts almonds, marigolds and pine leaves in aarikaam (worked with a hook).
