



A Tamilian Woman

Her dark complexion offset by the richness of a handwoven silk Kanchipuram saree, the characteristic wide border of which depicts the peacock in golden weaves, orange kanakambaram and white mallipoov flowers in her hair, combined with traditional ornaments, bedeck this Tamilian girl. The jimbidi or bell shaped ear ornament is held also by a gold mantal (chain) which is hooked in the hair. The besan is worn in the nose, a sigappu kal addigai, red stone necklace encircles the neck, while the thali kodi in gold, a symbol of marriage hangs lower, almost hidden in the saree folds.


