

Morenweiser Update India Type 5A & 6 DHT cachet in violet

I recently added two covers to my collection, both with the Morenweiser 2011 - India Types 5A and 6 DHT (Censor Station – Delhi) cachets in violet. This mark was in use only between April 1944-1945 primarily on inland and forces mail. These have been recorded in the catalogue as in black ink only (see Morenweiser 2011, p. 19 & 22). Here are two examples in violet.

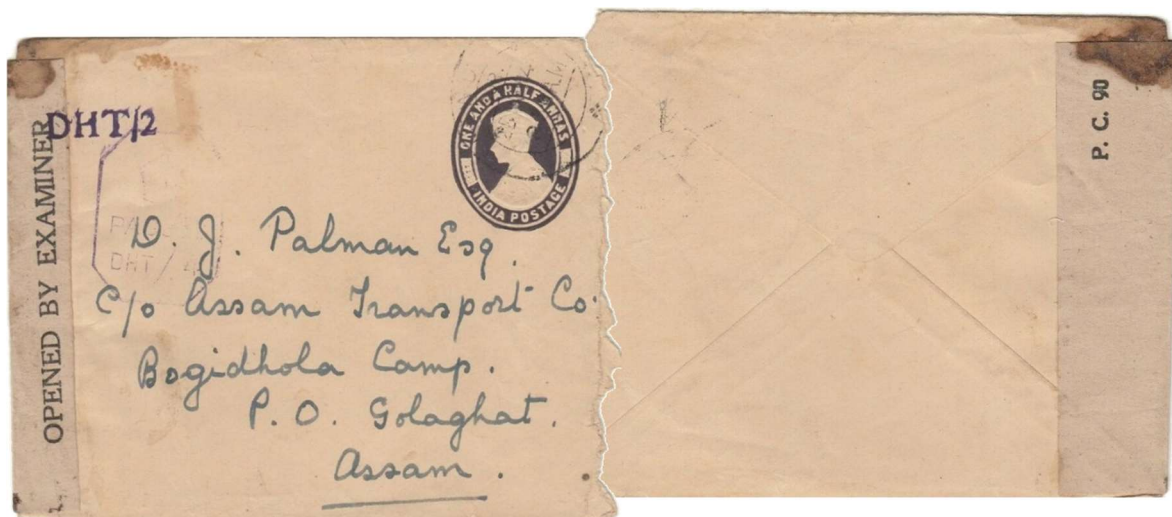


Fig 1 - 1½ anna KGVI stationary envelope cancelled NEW DELHI / SOR / 25 NOV 4x addressed to P.O. Golaghat, Assam, and resealed with a PC-90 OPENED BY EXAMINER label. Type 5A DHT/2 and Type 6 DHT/4 cachets in violet.

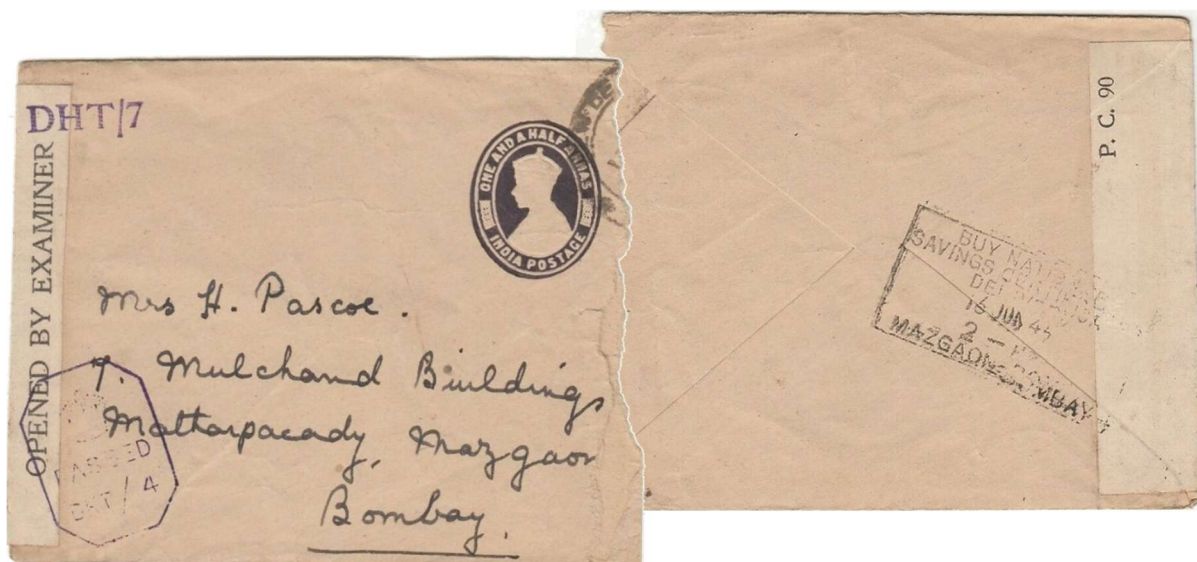


Fig 2 - 1½ anna KGVI stationary envelope cancelled NEW DELHI / (date illegible) addressed to Mazgaon, Bombay with a boxed rectangular delivery handstamp on the reverse MAZGAON BOMBAY / DELIVERY / 16 JUN 44. Resealed with a PC-90 OPENED BY EXAMINER label. Type 5A DHT/7 and Type 6 DHT/4 cachets in violet.
