

1990

THIS DAY, THAT YEAR, We completed "OPERATION AIRLIFT"

This was the biggest evacuation by a civilian airline of 1,11,711 Indians from Amman in Jordan to India after the invasion of Kuwait. Airlindia responded to the need and operated 488 flights for 59 continuous days. This massive operation got Air-India into the Guinness Book of World Records. I dedicate this poem as a tribute to our Airline and its magnificent Air-Indians who completed the operation on this day 20th October in 1990.
