

Air India Flight AI-182 operating with a 747- 237B aircraft VT- EFO named Kanishka, took off from Montreal in the early hours of 23 June 1985. The final destination was Mumbai with stops at London and New Delhi.

Around 0715 GMT, the plane was cruising at 31,000 feet over Irish waters when a bomb detonated in the carriage.

All 329 people on the plane - 268 Canadians (mostly of Indian descent), 27 Britons and 24 Indians including 22 Crew members - died.

The bombing of Air India Flight 182 was the largest mass killing in Canadian history, the deadliest aviation accident in the history of Air India and the most reprehensible act of aviation terrorism.

On June 23, 1985, Air-India's 747 'Kanishka' disappeared off the radar screen to plunge into the murky waters of the Atlantic, about 100 miles off the Irish Coast. The aircraft was operating as flight AI-182 from Canada to India and on board were 307 passengers including 8 Air-India satff, and 22 crew. While it has been established that the aircraft was cruising at 31,000 feet before the accident, the cause has yet to be determined.

All over the world, especially in India and Canada, numbed relatives were unable to accept the reality of this distressing tragedy. Sorrow and despair quickly changed into shock and horror.

To the inconsolable families of those who perished, every single one of us in Air-India offers our deepest sympathies. We are one with you in your great grief. May the souls of your dear departed rest in peace.
