Mumbai: Air-India (AI) is currently training 52 employees of Ariana Afghan Airline (AAA) in different aviation streams, AI officials stated.

AI officials said it is training three captains, three first officers, three flight engineers, six flight dispatchers, 18 cabin crew members, 17 aircraft maintenance engineers and two inspectors of Afghan's directorate general of civil aviation. The cabin crew includes four women.

According to AI officials the training, which began recently, is the result of the Centre's decision to gift three Airbus A-300s from AI's fleet to the government of Afghanistan for reviving the nation's civil aviation sector, which has been crippled by the long war. The Centre will pay AI \$10 million for the three planes, they said.

Batches of AI pilots will be based at Kabul in rotation. A spokesperson of the airline dismissed suggestions that the pilots
